1/2 TEASPOON OF ALMOND EXTRACT

1 EGG

2 1/2 CUPS OF ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR

1 TEASPOON OF BAKING SODA

1 TEASPOON OF CREAM OF TARTAR

(NO EXACT MEASUREMENTS)

STRAWBERRY JELL-O

POWERDERED SUGAR



INSTRUCTIONS

MIX THE POWERDERED SUGAR, BUTTER, VANILLA, ALMOND EXTRACT, AND EGG
THEN THE REST OF THE INGREDIENTS. COVER AND REFRIGERATE FOR AT LEAST 3 HOURS.

HEAT YOUR OVEN TO 375 DEGREES, ROLL OUT THE DOUGH AND CUT OUT INTO HEARTS.

SET DOWN ON A GREASED PAN AND BAKE FOR 7 TO 8 MINUTES. LET COOL BEFORE DRIZZLING FROSTING



Day actually finds its


roots in ancient Rome

The Catholic church has records of at least three different martyrs named Valentine. One of them, a priest in third century Rome, defied the emperor Claudius when he decided to outlaw marriage for young men. Valentine continued performing marriage ceremonies for the lovers in secret, and Claudius had him killed for it when he found out.

While Valentine was jailed, he began sending letters to the jailor's daughter and would sign the cards "From your Valentine". This expression is still used today, and that is why we send "Valentine's cards"
