- a description of the distance learning model including the daily schedule for each grade span (elementary, middle school, and high school),
- a clear description of the roles and responsibilities of all ABLÉ stakeholders (students, parents, teachers, support staff),
- COVID-19 screening procedures for visitors to campus,
- dates and procedures for picking up computers and school materials and supplies,
- school breakfast and lunch procedures,
- procedures related to student and family support beyond the distance "classroom",
- when class lists and student schedules will be posted,
- information regarding support for students with special needs, and
- all other relevant information families will need for the start of school.

Apologies for the slight delay. We have had some excellent input from our families in the development of our plans, but I want to be as inclusive as possible regarding these very important decisions.
