• Draft plan is presented to ABLE faculty for feedback.

• Draft plan is presented to focus groups composed of various stakeholders.

Draft plan in most up-to-date form is presented to the ABLE Board of Directors.

November 19*

• Draft plan is presented to all ABLE families at a virtual town hall meeting.

November 20*

Plan is finalized reflecting feedback and posted on the ABLE website.

November 23 - 25

• Messaging to families and request for formal decisions regarding distance or in-person learning.

November 30 – December 4

• Push to have families complete selection process including advisor contact and staff phone calls.

December 7 – 11

• Final decisions received or made for families that do not respond to survey.

December 14 – 18

• Finalize changes to teaching assignments to accommodate the plan and inform faculty.

December 14 – January 1

Master schedule and student schedules are revised to reflect families' choices.

December 16

• Final plan including data regarding families' choices is presented to the ABLE Board of Directors for ratification.

January 4 – 15

Make necessary adjustments to student and teacher schedules.

January 11 – 22

Determine the appropriate window for requiring all ABLE staff to be tested for COVID-19 in readiness
for in-person student contact and determine intervals for regular employee testing through the end of the
school year.

January 19 – 27

• Schedule a non-student contact day for teachers and administrators to internalize the plan and prepare for implementation.
